Our **English Intensive** course is divided into 3 levels (each level cost **N\$ 3500.00** plus **N\$ 30.00** Application fee) that is; **Elementary, Intermediate** and **Advanced** levels. When classes begin the students write a placement test which determines the level into which they fall. Each level runs for a semester, 240 hours per level, but they should pass the advanced level with a 60% and above to be admitted into our University qualification. This is also subject to the availability of space and their performance in their school leaving certificate.

For one to qualify for a Bachelor's degree, they must at least have **25** points or higher in **5 subjects** of their school leaving certificate, according to Namibia Qualification Authority (**NQA**). Which means the prospective students should get their results transcribed into English and then submitted to **NQA** which then evaluates and converts the results to our standards.

As for **ACCOMMODATION**, we unfortunately do not provide. Students should look for their own accommodation in Windhoek.

- **Police clearance from Home Country**
- **(Study permit fee for the years of study will only be paid once your application has been approved. N\$ 2000.00 TIMES YEARS OF STUDY). This is not paid during registration or application process.**
- **Reasons for studying in Namibia**
- **Proof of Medical Aid/Insurance (Valid and active)**
- **Proof of accommodation in Namibia**
