## Admission requirements

- Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBChB) degree from UNAM or equivalent degree from an accredited institution outside the country.
- Registration with the Health Professions Councils of Namibia (HPCNA) as a general practitioner.
- Proficiency in English is necessary, especially where candidates are trained in a language other than English.
- Candidates are required to practise predominantly in primary care (private or public) or district hospital settings for the duration of the course, seeing ambulatory patients. Prior experience in primary care practice will be an advantage.
