Special Admission Consideration

The University of Namibia hereby invites prospective Namibian students who fall into any one of the categories below, to apply for Conditional Admission Consideration:

- 1. Applicants who have obtained 25 or 26 points with at least 2 AS (minimum e symbol)/ HIGCSE (minimum 4 symbol) or equivalent subjects and minimum NSSCO English C symbol AND meeting ALL the programme specific subject grades;
- 2. Applicants who have obtained at least 27 points with at least 2 AS (minimum e symbol)/ HIGCSE (minimum 4 symbol) or equivalent, subjects but have one symbol lower in English (i.e. NSSCO / IGCSE or equivalent English D symbol) and / or other programme specific grade requirements;
- 3. Applicants who have obtained at least 28 points with at least 1 HIGCSE or equivalent subject (minimum 4 symbol), and minimum IGCSE or equivalent English C symbol AND meeting ALL the programme specific subject grades.

Prospective students who meet the requirements in any of the categories above, will be admitted and enrolled conditionally for the 2025 academic year.

To ensure continued registration beyond the 2025 academic year, one of the following conditions must be met before a student will be allowed to register for 2026:

- Pass the first year, i.e. receive an annual result code "pass first year" at the end of 2025:
- Pass all modules related to the school subject(s) in which the required grades were not met:
- Upgrade his/her school results in those particular subjects in order to meet the normal admission criteria.

The specific conditions applicable will be communicated to students during registration. Failure to meet the conditions, will result in the termination of studies.

Please note the following:

- This offer is only open to undergraduate degree programmes with standard admission requirements:
- Conditional admission will NOT be considered for any professional programmes;
- Conditional admission will NOT be considered for any diploma programmes.
