Tyler Award for Outstanding and Distinguished Research (2013), WACE Donald McLaren Academic Award for Professional Achievement in Cooperative and Work-Integrated Education (2015), the CEIA James W. Wilson Award for Outstanding Contribution to Research in the Field of Cooperative Education and Internships (2019), the Fellow of Work-Integrated Learning New Zealand (WILNZ) award (2020), and the WACE Research Excellence Award (2024).

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
